



## How To Enable Your iPhone’s Tap Feature




**Step 1:**  
After creating your free Go RTS Fares account using your UF email address, click on the Menu option at the bottom of your screen, then choose IDs.




Step 2:  
At the IDs screen,  
you'll click on Add  
ID at the bottom.




**Step 3:**  
Click in the Select Type field, and then choose Apple Pay ID from the popup menu at the bottom of the screen.





Step 4:  
Once Apple Pay ID  
has been chosen  
and is listed in the  
text field at top,  
click "Save".




**Step 5:**  
Click Yes when you get this message about disabling barcode scanning. Scanning will only be disabled for the Go RTS Fares app.




**Step 6:**  
Click Yes when you get this message about Apple Pay. This will open up the Apple Pay dialog, but you will not be charged anything – the specified amount is a placeholder only.



**Step 7:**  
The Apple Pay dialog screen will open and show a \$1 payment to Go RTS Fares through your current payment method. You will not be charged anything at all, though, it's just a placeholder as part of the setup process. Use your side button to confirm "yes" when you see this message.



Step 8:  
You'll now see the  
new ID token for  
Go RTS Fares listed  
on the IDs screen if  
the process was  
successful.



## Step 9:

Click back to your Home screen on Go RTS Fares, and your barcode should now display an iPhone image like this.

Congratulations, you did it! You can now tap your iPhone on the validator instead of scanning when you board our shuttles.
